Top selling bull was Lot 3 with one-half interest in Tally-Ho 777T being sold to Brian Heinze, Roseburg, OR for \$10,500.00. This standout bull had a weaning weight of 804 lbs. Thick, deep and well muscled out of the Coley Mojito 503R and dam Perks Miss Divide 006R with a 102.2 MPPA.

Second high selling bull was Lot 4, Tycoon 750T, with 75 percent interest being sold to Doug Mullings, Fairgrove, MO for \$7,400.00. Tycoon 750T's great grandmother 4L MS RAMBO R701 produced the top performing heifer one year and the top performing bull the next year.

Lot number 1, Tennessean, was third-high selling bull for the day. Two-thirds interest in this bull was purchased by Barry Langley, Wilton, IA for \$6,000.00. Tennessean was named Reserve Calf Champion at the NWSS and went on to win his class at the National Red Angus Show.
