Built on a solid reputation of progressive breeders that raise some of the elite and breed-leading Red Angus genetics anywhere, the NILE continues to be one of the most prestigious sales in the Red Angus breed. Each year consignors work diligently to showcase offspring of popular breed sires, such as Grand Cherokee, Red Fine Line Mulberry 26P, Glacier Chateau and others. Held at the Metra Park facility during a week of rodeos and various events, consignors not only showcased their cattle for the actual sale, but also participated in a pre-sale show and Futurity event. The MTRAA did a phenomenal job in organizing a top notch event and the weather couldn't have been better either. No snow shovels needed this year!

Rich Red Angus, Vinton, IA won the lottery with their \$8,000 bid for Lot 15, Fischer Lakme 123. She is a dazzling and powerful, Red SSS Pursue 99M January 2011 daughter. Her dam is a New Trend X Hobo 1961 daughter from the Lakme cow family. This animal was consigned by Ron & Esther Fischer, Fischer Red Angus, Harlowton, MT.

The second high selling female of the day, lot 52, was purchased by Brenner Angus, Carson, North Dakota, for \$7,500. Suth Flaming Toni 1013 is a February 2011 Red Northline Fat Tony 605U daughter and one of the first Fat Tony daughters to sell in the United States! Her dam is Suth Chateau Flame 182N. Bob & Laurie Sutherlin, Sutherlin Farms of Stevensville, MT were the consignors.

Crump Red Angus, Gillette, WY, successfully outbid others to get another featured female in the sale. Lot 17, Milk Crk Sheba 048, sold for \$7,250. This outstanding bred heifer is a February 2010 daughter of 5L Blazin Trail 1336-237V out of Milk Crk Sheba 748. She was consigned by Milk Creek Reds – Plevna, MT

The only bull in the sale was purchased by Revolution Ranch of Ethridge, MT for \$4,000. This Red Fine Line Mulberry 26P son out of BCRR Opal 6130S was a stand out from birth and one of the top

performing calves at Bullis Creek Ranch of Wood Lake, NE. Not only has he performed well in the field, but has been a winner on the tarmac!

The top selling embryo package at the 2011 NILE, lot 40 was the result of Fine Line Mulberry 26P X Raisland Rebella 120-502. Michael Tillman, Havre, MT placed the winning bid of \$3,900 and they were consigned by Raisland Red Angus, St. Ignatius, MT.

The second top selling embryo package, lot 13A sold for \$2,700 to Everett Flikkema, Wood Lake, NE. These sensational embryos are the results of an LCJ Mission Statement P27 X Buf Crk Marigold L231 breeding. This embryo package was consigned by C-T Red Angus & Klompfen Red Angus, Manhattan, MT.

Another embryo package, lot 13B, went to Bullis Creek Ranch, Wood Lake, NE for \$2,700. This valuable package is the result of combining the high profile bull Messmer Packer S008 X Buf Crk Marigold L231. C-T Red Angus & Klompfen Red Angus, Manhattan, MT were the consignors.

Cattle and embryos sold into 10 states including: California, Colorado, Iowa, Kansas, Montana, Nebraska, North Dakota, Oregon, Washington and Wyoming.
